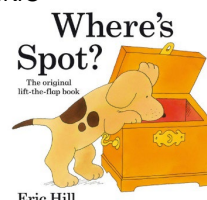


October 2025

In Nursery Twos this month, we will be:

- Learning about the story 'Where's Spot?' which is our core book for the half term.
- Learning different rhymes and action songs. Our rhyme of the month is 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star'.
- Exploring the colours red, orange and yellow through our play.
- Using apples collected from our garden to make apple crumble!
- Learning about the season of Autumn to support our understanding of the world around us. We will participate in lots of Autumn themed activities such as using natural resources to make hedgehogs, exploring pumpkins using all of our senses and adding different autumnal resources to our playdough such as leaves and twigs.
